Union-Snyder CAA Services Overview

Union-Snyder CAA provides programs and services to address barriers related to poverty to help individuals and families living with low income reach self-sufficiency. Below is an overview of basic CAA services. For questions regarding these services, please call us at (570) 374-0181.

NOTE: Service Navigation is offered to income-eligible individuals who are interested in overcoming life barriers and setting clear goals to increase their long-term stability throughout all components. Please call us for more information.

Community Services (Selinsgrove):

- Housing Assistance: Income-eligible individuals and families living in Union or Snyder County; includes Rapid Rehousing and Homeless Assistance Program
- <u>Utility Assistance:</u> Income-eligible individuals and families that need help paying home heating and/or electric bills to avoid shut offs; PPL and UGI assistance
- <u>Transportation Assistance:</u> Income-eligible transportation assistance (i.e. car purchase, repair, mileage reimbursement, or rabbittransit) for working parents with children under 18; must live in Union or Snyder County
- Food Referrals: Monthly food pantries, community meals, food distributions, etc.
- The Linen Closet (TLC): Personal hygiene products and cleaning supplies for CAA customers
- Information & Referrals: Navigation through other local service options

Education & Employment (Selinsgrove and Lewisburg):

- Adult Education: Assistance attaining GED or other educational goal
- Parenting: Learn skills and discuss information/topics to create a safe environment for family
- <u>Employment Skills:</u> Assistance with attaining employment includes soft skills coaching, job search techniques, resume/cover letter writing, etc.
- Computer Skills: Learn basics of Microsoft Office, navigating computers, etc.
- Financial Literacy: Learn how to get out of debt, get on top of bills, budgeting, etc.
- Re-Entry: Assistance re-entering society after incarceration; includes opportunities for completing community service hours
- Anger Management (Lewisburg only): Learn healthy ways to manage emotions
